

Myers-Stevens Coverage

Myers-Stevens provides supplemental accident coverage toward injuries or death sustained during school time activities under specified conditions.

Blanket Coverage

Our District purchases “Blanket Coverage” for trips to educational ‘only’ venues and no additional paperwork is required by sites to assure protection. **Sites MUST maintain records of field trips including dates, times, destination, trip activities, permission slips, participant attendance and supervision.** This covers field trips meeting ALL of the following criteria:

- Trips inside of the scheduled instructional day, “school time”*
- Non Excursion/Amusement/Recreation Trips even outside of the instructional Day
- Non Excursion/Amusement/Recreation Trips even on weekends
- Directly Supervised Field Trips.

**This coverage includes protection for walking field trips to educational ‘only’ venues.*

Overnight/Excursion/VTWT Field Trip Coverage –

This is a required supplemental coverage purchased by sites at a cost of \$1.85 per person. To purchase this coverage for trips involving entertainment, reward, VTWT, more risky activities including parks, overnight, and excursions, please fax the enclosed form to Myers-Stevens. This coverage is required for field trips meeting the following criteria:

- Trips that are primarily for Recreation or Amusement/Entertainment (Sports Events, Theme Parks and Attractions)
- Trips with activities that include greater risk (Tide Pools, Beach, Nature Hikes)
- Voluntary Trips Without Transportation (Outside of school time only)
- Excursions or field trips: (Example: Disneyland, Knott’s Berry Farm)*
- Overnight Field Trips

**Excursions or field trips where there may be periods of time unsupervised or out of direct supervision require special permission slips. Please contact Risk Management for details.*
